COOKING CAMP - \$50

Cooking Camp provides a fun and safe environment for Villagers to be able to learn basic cooking skills, develop more independence in the kitchen and try out new and delicious recipes. Each day Villagers will learn a new recipe from local chefs.

ART CAMP - \$50

TUESDAYS | JUNE 13, 20, 27, JULY 11, 18, 25 | 4:30-5:30PM

Art Camp provides Villagers with the opportunity to use their creativity through arts and crafts. From book making with Miss Megan's Make Room to food props with Lubbock Community Theatre, each day Villagers will be given a new project taught by various local fine art professionals.

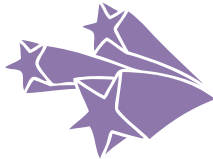

SPORTS & FITNESS CAMP - \$50

WEDNESDAYS | JUNE 14, 21, 28, JULY 12, 19, 26 | 4:30-5:30PM

Sports and Fitness Camp will give Villagers the opportunity to learn about and play a variety of different sports, such as tennis and basketball. Villagers will also get to participate in games and activities led by local fitness instructors and athletes.

ADVENTURE DAY CAMP

AUGUST 11 | 9AM-8PM | \$75

Villagers will be dropped off at Adventure Park at 9am for a morning of zip lines, rope courses and adventure. We will then take them to High Point Village for lunch before heading to the Texas Tech pool and lazy river. Villagers will end the day back at High Point for a cook out and movie.

QUALIFICATIONS

At High Point Village, we strive to ensure that our Villagers, volunteers and staff remain safe, healthy and happy! For that reason, potential Villagers must meet the following requirements:



- Have a primary diagnosis of an intellectual or developmental disability
- Be independent in mobility and the basic activities of daily living skills OR have an attendant who can assist them during camp
- Be free of physically aggressive and threatening behaviors

New Villagers must schedule a tour of our Enrichment Center. This tour will give our staff an opportunity to meet with you and your Villager.
